#### POST OFFICE ACT

### LOCAL POST (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 54 of the Post Office Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following regulations -

## Title and commencement.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Local Post (Amendment) Regulations 2004, and shall come into effect on the 13th September 2004.

### Amendments to the Local Post Regulations.

2. The Local Post Regulations, hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations" are amended in accordance with the provisions of these regulations.

## Amendment to regulation 20.

3. Regulation 20 of the principal Regulations is amended in sub-regulation (1) by omitting the figure "£1.40" and substituting therefor the figure "£1.80".

## Amendment to regulation 24.

4. Regulation 24 of the principal Regulations is amended in sub-regulation (2) by omitting the figure "£1.20" and substituting therefor the figure "£1.60".

### Amendment to Schedule 1.

- 5. Schedule 1 of the principal Regulation is amended
  - (a) in item 1. Letter, in the second column delete the words "for every 50 grammes or part thereof 5p" and substitute the

- words "for the first 50 grammes or part thereof 7p. For every additional 50 grammes or part thereof 5p";
- (b) in item 2. Postcard, in the second column delete "5p" and substitute "7p";
- (c) item 3. Printed packet, is deleted in its entirety;
- (d) item 4. Newspapers printed in Gibraltar and addressed to subscribers in Gibraltar or Spain is amended—
  - (i) in the first column by deleting the words "or Spain";
  - (ii) in the second column by deleting the words "per copy
    3p." and substituting the words "for the first 50 grammes or part thereof 5p. For every additional 50 grammes or part thereof 5p";
- (e) item 5. Sample packet, is deleted in its entirety;
- (f) item 7. Small packet is deleted in its entirety.
