**POST OFFICE ORDINANCE**

**LOCAL POST (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2006**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 5, 7, 8, 10, 12 and 54 of the Post Office Ordinance, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following regulations—

**Title.**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Local Post (Amendment) Regulations 2006.

**Amendment to regulation 2.**

2. The Local Post Regulations (the Principal Regulations) are amended after “express packet” in regulation 2 by inserting the following new definition—

““first class letter” means a letter that will be given priority for local delivery over and above the standard local mail service;”.

**New regulation 33.**

3. The Principal Regulations are amended after regulation 32 by inserting a new regulation 33 as follows—

**“Public Information of Local Postal Rates.**

33. The Director of Postal Services shall display at the central lobby of the Main Street Post Office Schedule 1 of these Regulations for such periods of time as he may deem reasonable.”.

**Amendment of Schedule 1.**

4. The Principal Regulations are amended in Schedule 1 in the first column of the first row after the figure “1” insert “(a)”; and at the bottom of the first row entitled “1. Letter” along the four respective columns insert the following order–

“1(b) First class letters” “28 pence – each” “same as above” and “up to 20 grammes”.
