## POST OFFICE ACT

## COMMONWEALTH AND FOREIGN POST (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 54 of the Post Office Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following regulations–

#### Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Commonwealth and Foreign Post (Amendment) Regulations 2004, and shall come into effect on the  $13^{\text{th}}$  September 2004.

#### Amendments to the Commonwealth and Foreign Post Regulations.

2. The Commonwealth and Foreign Post Regulation, hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations" are amended in accordance with the provisions of these regulations.

#### **Revocation of Regulation 10.**

3. Regulation 10 of the principal Regulations is hereby revoked.

#### Amendment to Regulation 11.

4. Paragraph (h) including its proviso, of subregulation 11(2) of the principal Regulations, is hereby revoked.

#### Amendment to Regulation 27.

5. Regulation 27 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting the figure " $\pounds$ 1.40" and substituting the figure " $\pounds$ 1.80".

## Amendment to Regulation 30.

6. Subregulation 30(2) of the principal Regulations is amended in paragraph (c) by deleting the figure "£1.05" and substituting the figure "£1.60".

#### Amendments to Regulation 37.

- 7. Regulation 37 of the principal Regulations is amended-
  - (a) in subregulation (1) by deleting the words "of thirty five pence" and substituting the words "at the same amount as the air-mail rate of a 10 gramme letter to the country of destination";
  - (b) in subregulation (3) by deleting the words "five pence" and substituting the words "the same amount as the air-mail rate of a 10 gramme letter to the country of destination".

## **Revocation of subregulation 37(2).**

8. Subregulation 37(2) of the principal Regulations is hereby revoked.

#### **Replacement of Schedule 2.**

9. Schedule 2 of the principal Regulation is replaced by the following-.
