POST OFFICE ORDINANCE

**COMMONWEALTH AND FOREIGN POST (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 2006**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 5, 7, 8, 10, 12 and 54 of the Post Office Ordinance, and all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following Regulations—

Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Commonwealth and Foreign Post (Amendment) Regulations 2006 and come into operation on 1st September 2006.

Amendments to the Commonwealth and Foreign Post Regulations.

2.(1) The Commonwealth and Foreign Post Regulations (“the Principal Regulations”) are amended in accordance with the provisions of this regulation.

(2) Schedule 2 is amended in Part IA by substituting the figure “38p” in the three places with “40p”.

(3) Schedule 2 is amended in Part IB by substituting the figure “40p” in the three places with “42p”.

(4) Schedule 2 is amended as follows—

(i) In Part II “COUNTRIES OUTSIDE EUROPE.

(a) Postal packets—”

by underneath the first column titled “First 10 grammes or part thereof” by substituting the figure “47p” in both places with “49p”;

- (ii) in the third column titled "Air Letters" by substituting the figure "44p" in both places with "46p"; and
- (iii) underneath the fourth column titled "Postcards" by substituting the figure "47p" in both places with "49p".
