**PRISON ACT 2011**

**PRISON (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2012**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 71 of the Prison Act 2011, the Minister has made the following Regulations—

**Title and commencement.**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Prison (Amendment) Regulations 2012 and come into operation on the day of publication.

**Amendment of regulations.**

2. In the Prison Regulations 2011 for regulation 38 substitute—

**“Remission of sentence.**

38.(1) A prisoner serving a sentence of imprisonment or detention for an actual term of more than five days may, on the ground of his industry and good conduct, be granted remission of not more than one third of the term of his sentence.

(2) For the purposes of subregulation (1)—

- (a) a person committed to prison in default of payment of a sum adjudged to be paid by a conviction shall be treated as serving a sentence of imprisonment; and
- (b) consecutive terms of imprisonment shall be treated as one term.

(3) No remission of any sentence imposed on a prisoner shall reduce the time spent in prison by such prisoner to less than five days.

(4) Subregulation (1) shall have effect subject to any disciplinary award of forfeiture of remission.”.
