PUBLIC HEALTH ACT.

INTERPRETATION AND GENERAL CLAUSES ACT.

**CONTROL OF MAJOR ACCIDENT HAZARDS OF CERTAIN
INDUSTRIAL ACTIVITIES (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1994.**

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 23 of the Interpretation and General Clauses Act, and of all other enabling powers, and for the purpose of transposing into the national law of Gibraltar, Council Directive 82/501/EEC, as amended, the Government has made the following regulations –

Title and commencement.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Control of Major Accident Hazards of Certain Industrial Activities (Amendment) Regulations 1994 and shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 27th day of October, 1994.

Amendment to Schedule 7.

2. Schedule 7 to the Control of Major Accident Hazards of Certain Industrial Activities Regulations 1994 is amended –

- (a) by omitting paragraph 1 and substituting therefor the following paragraph

"1. Installation for the production, processing or treatment of organic or inorganic chemicals using for this purpose amongst others –

Alkylation
Amination by ammonolysis
Carbonylation
Condensation
Dehydrogenation
Esterification

Halogenation and manufacture of halogenes
Hydrogenation
Hydrolysis
Oxidation
Polymerization
Sulphonation
Desulphurization, manufacture and transformation of
sulphur-containing compounds
Nitration and manufacture of nitrogeon-containing
compounds
Manufacture of phosphorous-containing compounds
Formulation of pesticides and of pharmaceutical
products
Distillation
Extraction
Solbation
Mixing";

- (b) in paragraph 4 by omitting the words "or processing" and substituting therefor a comma and the words "processing or treatment".
