INTERPRETATION AND GENERAL CLAUSES ACT

PUBLIC HEALTH ACT

**PUBLIC HEALTH ACT (AMENDMENT TO SECTIONS 5 AND 13)
REGULATIONS, 1996**

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 23 of the Interpretation and General Clauses Act and of all other enabling powers, and for the purpose of transposing into the national law of Gibraltar Council Directive 91/271/EEC, the Government has made the following regulations —

Title and commencement.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Public Health Act (Amendment to sections 5 and 13) Regulations, 1996, and shall come into effect on the 1st day of March 1996.

Amendment to the Public Health Act.

2. The Public Health Act is amended —

(a) in section 5 by —

(i) inserting after the figure “5” the figure “(1)”;

(ii) inserting after sub-section (1), as now so designated the following new sub-sections —

“ (2) The Government shall carry out or cause to be carried out the obligations of this section and sections 6 to 14 in such manner as to comply with the requirements of Council Directive 91/271/EEC Concerning Urban Waste Water Treatment, as amended from time to time, or such other Directive applicable in Gibraltar as may replace or supersede that Directive, and in accordance with regulations made under sub-section (3).

(3) The Government shall make regulations for the purpose of transposing Council Directive 91/271/EEC, as amended from time to time, or such other Directive applicable in Gibraltar as may replace or supersede that Directive, into Gibraltar law and such regulations may create offences and impose penalties in respect of those offences.”;

(b) in section 13(1) by —

- (i) omitting the fullstop at the end of paragraph (c) and substituting therefor a semi-colon;
- (ii) inserting after paragraph (c) the following new paragraph (d) —

“(d) industrial waste water, as defined in regulations made under section 5(3) except in accordance with any relevant provisions of those regulations.”.
