AN ACT to amend the Public Health Act.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Public Health Act (Amendment) Act and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st July 1999.

Amendments to the Public Health Act.

2. The Public Health Act shall be amended in Schedule 3 as follows -

- (a) the existing paragraph shall be amended by inserting prior to the words “The general rate shall be” the following words and reference -

“(1) Subject to paragraph (2) below,”;

- (b) the following paragraphs shall be inserted after paragraph (1) -

“(2) A special poundage shall apply to hereditaments which are used for a qualifying activity.

- (3) In this Schedule -

“qualifying activity” means the following activities -

- (a) retail in goods;
- (b) wholesale in goods;
- (c) construction, manufacturing and repair, not being construction, manufacturing and repair relating to premises used in connection with the production, distribution or sale of electricity, water or telecommunications services;
- (d) transport and distribution,

or such other activity as the Government may, from time to time, prescribe by notice in the Gazette;

“special poundage” means 55 pence in the pound on the full net annual value of a hereditament.”.
