INTERPRETATION AND GENERAL CLAUSES ACT

PUBLIC HEALTH ACT (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2010

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 23(g)(ii) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Act and in order to partly transpose Council Directive 2004/113/EC of 13 December 2004 implementing the principle of equal treatment between men and women in the access to and supply of goods and services, the Government has made the following Regulations-

Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health Act (Amendment) Regulations 2010 and come into operation on the day of publication.

Amendment of the Public Health Act.

2. In section 76(1)(b) of the Public Health Act delete the words “, other than urinals”.

Explanatory Memorandum

These Regulations amend the Public Health Act so as to remove the sex discrimination that arises in connection with the Government's power to charge fees for the use of certain public sanitary conveniences.
