## INTERPRETATION AND GENERAL CLAUSES ACT

## PUBLIC HEALTH ACT (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2014

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 23(g)(ii) of the Interpretation and General Clauses Act, and in order to transpose into the law of Gibraltar Article 30 of Directive 2012/18/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 4 July 2012 on the control of majoraccident hazards involving dangerous substances, amending and subsequently repealing Council Directive 96/82/EC, the Government has made the following Regulations—

#### Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health Act (Amendment) Regulations 2014 and come into operation on 15 February 2014.
