PUBLIC HEALTH ACT.

RECREATION GROUNDS (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1986.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 265 of the Public Health Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following rules:

Title.

1.(1) These rules may be cited as the Recreation Grounds (Amendment) Rules, 1986.

(2) These rules shall come into operation on the 1st day of May 1986.

Amendment of Rule 17.

2. Rule 17 of the Recreation Grounds Rules (hereinafter called the "principal rules") is amended by inserting after sub-rule (i) the following:

"(iA) fail to remove a tent, booth, stand, building or other structure in respect of which permission has not been granted under sub-rule (i) after being required to remove it by an officer of the Government or by a Police officer;

(iB) persist in remaining in a tent, booth, stand, building or other structure (whether erected by himself or not) in respect of which permission has not been granted under sub-rule (i) after being required to leave it by an officer of the Government or by a Police officer, or after leaving it returns to it without the permission of such officer;"

Amendment of Rule 21.

3. Rule 21 of the principal rules is amended by omitting the expression "£10" and substituting therefor the expression "£50".
