PUBLIC HEALTH ACT.

RECREATION GROUNDS (AMENDMENT) RULES 1990.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 265 of the Public Health Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following rules—

Title and commencement.

1. (1) These Rules may be cited as the Recreation Grounds (Amendment) Rules 1990.

(2) These Rules shall come into operation on 28th day of April 1990.

Amendment to Rule 13.

2. The proviso to Rule 13 of the Recreation Grounds Rules (hereinafter called "the principal rules") is amended by

(a) omitting everything after "charge";

(b) inserting new subparagraphs as follows—

"(a) at any time to enter or remain in the garden opposite the western entrance to the Cathedral of the Holy Trinity; and

(b) between 28th day of April 1990 and the 8th day of October 1990 to enter or remain in the following recreation grounds - the Alameda Gardens, Rosia Saluting Battery Promenade, Sir Herbert Miles Promenade, Line Wall War Memorial Promenade, the Garden off SmithDorrien Avenue at the site of Old Girakla Tower, the Piazza at John Mackintosh Square, the paved section north of Governor's Parade and the Adventure Playground off Winston Churchill Avenue."

Amendment to Schedule.

3. The Schedule to the principal rules is amended by omitting therefrom the words "Garden off Rosia Road opposite the northern end of Red Sands Road."
