PUBLIC HEALTH ACT.

SEASHORE (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1988

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 214 of the Public Health Act and all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following rules –

1. These rules may be cited as the Seashore (Amendment) Rules 1988.

Title.

2. Rule 9 of the Seashore Rules is amended by revoking subrule (P and substituting therefor the following subrule –

Amendment of rule 4.

"(1) The owner of a dog, and any person in charge of a dog, shall not allow such dog to be on the seashore –

(a) at any time on any day during the period from the last Saturday in April to the first Sunday in October (inclusive) in any year;

(b) between 10 am and 7.30 pm on any other day."
