PUBLIC HEALTH ACT.

SEASHORE (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) RULES, 1989

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 214 of the Public Health Act and of all other enabling powers the Governor has made the following rules

Title.

1. These rules may be cited as the Seashore (Amendment) (No. 2) Rules 1989.

Prohibition of angling.

2. The Seashore Rules are amended by inserting the following new rule after rule 7

"Angling 7A. (1) Angling is prohibited from any beach to which this rule applies except from such places as the Minister charged with responsibility for tourism may from time to time set apart for that purpose.

(2) The beaches to which this rule applies are Black Strap Cove (sometimes called Miami Beach), Camp Bay (including the Keys Promenade), Catalan Bay, Eastern Beach, Little Bay, Sandy Bay, Shirley Cove and Western Beach."
