PUBLIC HEALTH ACT

SEASHORE (AMENDMENT NO 2) RULES 2014

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 214 of the Public Health Act, and all other enabling powers, the Government has made the following rules—

Title.

1. These rules may be cited as the Seashore (Amendment No 2) Rules 2014.

Amendments to the Seashore Rules.

2. The Seashore Rules are amended as follows—

- (a) in rule 14, the words “or Eastern Beach” are deleted;
- (b) the following rule is added after rule 14 of the Seashore Rules—

“Camp Bay swimming Pool.

14A. No person shall use the swimming pool at Camp Bay when it is closed to the public; in particular no person shall climb over or through the fence surrounding the pool.”;

- (c) in rule 15, the words “Eastern Beach, Sandy Bay” are deleted;
- (d) in rule 17, “level 3” is replaced by “level 4”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

These rules provide for an additional offence of using Camp Bay swimming pool when it is closed, remove references to Eastern Beach paddling pools (which no longer exist) and increase the level of fines for contravention of the rules.
