PUBLIC HEALTH ACT

SEASHORE (AMENDMENT No 3) RULES 2014

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 214 of the Public Health Act, and all other enabling powers, the Government has made the following Rules—

Title.

1. These rules may be cited as the Seashore (Amendment No 3) Rules 2014.

Amendment to the Seashore Rules.

2. The Seashore Rules are amended by inserting the following Rule after Rule 13—

“Aqua stations

13A(1) A person shall only use, climb onto or swim in the immediate vicinity of the structures known as Aqua stations when an official lifeguard is on duty at or on the Aqua station.

- (2) All persons using or swimming in the immediate vicinity of an Aqua station must follow the instructions of the lifeguard on duty at that station, in particular in relation to the number of persons using it or swimming near it at any one time and in relation to behaviour on or near the station.”.

These Rules provide that Aqua stations may only be used when a lifeguard is on duty and that the instructions of the lifeguard must be obeyed (or an offence is committed).
