PUBLIC HEALTH ACT.

WATER (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) RULES, 1991.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 140 of the Public Health Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following rules—

Title.

1. These rules may be cited as the Water (Amendment) (No. 2) Rules, 1991.

Amendment to rule 2.

2. Rule 2 of the Water Rules (hereinafter called “the principal Rules”) is amended in subsection (1) by—

- (a) in the definition of “British Standard” inserting after the word “Institution” the words “or where there is a harmonised standard produced in accordance with the rules of the European Economic Community, that standard or specification”;
- (b) in the definition of “Director” omitting the words “the Director of Public Works” and substituting therefor the words “the person appointed by the Government for the purpose of administering these rules”.

Amendment to rule 62.

3. Rule 62 of the principal Rules is amended by omitting the words “Public Works Department” and substituting therefor the word “Government”.
