**PUBLIC HEALTH (QUALITY OF BATHING  
WATER) RULES, 1992**

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**ARRANGEMENT OF RULES.**

**Title.**

1. These rules may be cited as the Public Health (Quality of Bathing Water) Rules 1992.

**Interpretation.**

2. In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires,—

“Bathing Water Directive” means Council Directive 76/160 and any subsequent amendment to that Directive produced in accordance with the provisions of Article 9 thereof dealing with methods of analysis or parameter values;

“Commission” means a Commission of the European Communities;

“nominated authority” means the person nominated by the Government from time to time for the purpose of implementing in Gibraltar the Bathing Water Directive.

**Implementation of Bathing Water Directive.**

3. The Bathing Water Directive shall be implemented in Gibraltar by the nominated authority acting in accordance with—

- (a) the provisions of that Directive; and
- (b) the administrative instructions of the Government from time to time for the purpose of such implementation.

**Reporting procedures.**

4. (1) Reports shall be prepared by the Nominated Authority in accordance with the requirements of Article 13 of the Bathing Water Directive and shall be submitted by that person annually within three months of the termination of the bathing season to the Commission and shall be laid before the House of Assembly at the meeting thereof next ensuing after the submission of the report to the Commission.

- (2) Unless the nominated authority shall have indicated otherwise, the Commission may publish the information contained in the report referred to in sub-rule (1).
