PUBLIC HEALTH (POLLUTION OF GROUNDWATER) REGULATIONS, 1995

Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Pollution of Groundwater) Regulations, 1995 and shall come into effect 30 days after the day of publication.

Interpretation and Application.

- 2. (1) in these Regulations, unless the context shall otherwise require, "the Act" means the Public Health Act.
- (2) The amendments made by these Regulations to the provisions of the Act shall apply to any discharge or disposal or tipping occurring on or after the day on which these regulations are effective:

Provided that where the competent authority designated for the purposes of Couicil Directive 80/68/EEC by the Government is satisfied that—

- (a) the discharge, disposal or tipping had been taking place in the course of otherwise lawful activity prior to the effective day and that activity was being carried on on that day; and
- (b) the discharge is one in respect of which an authorisation may be issued by the competent authority; and
- (c) an application has been made to the competent authority in accordance with rules made under section 70 of the Act, as amended by these regulations, for an authorisation in respect of that discharge, disposal or tipping,

it shall not be an offence to carry on that activity for a period not exceeding 30 days from the day on which these regulations are effective by virtue of regulation 1 (or such longer period not exceeding 60 days as the competent authority may in its discretion permit).

Regulation 3 amends section 69 of the Act.

Regulation 4 amends section 70 of the Act.
