INTERPRETATION AND GENERAL CLAUSES ACT

END-OF LIFE VEHICLES (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2010

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 23(g)(ii) as read with section 27 of the Interpretation and General Clauses Act, and all other enabling powers, and in order to partly transpose into the law of Gibraltar Directive 2008/112/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 December 2008 amending Council Directives 76/768/EEC, 88/378/EEC, 1999/13/EC and Directives 2000/53/EC, 2002/96/EC and 2004/42/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council in order to adapt them to Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008 on classification, labelling and packaging of substances and mixtures, the Government has made the following Regulations—

Title and commencement.

1.(1) These Regulations may be cited as the End-of Life Vehicles (Amendment) Regulations 2010 and come into operation on 1 December 2010.

Amendment of Rules.

2. In rule 2 of the End-of Life Vehicles Rules 2004 for the definition of "hazardous substance" substitute the following definition—

""hazardous substance" means any substance which fulfils the criteria for any of the following hazard classes or categories set out in Annex I of Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 December 2008 on classification, labelling and packaging of substances and mixtures;

(a) hazard classes 2.1 to 2.4, 2.6 and 2.7, 2.8 types A and B, 2.9, 2.10, 2.12, 2.13 categories 1 and 2, 2.14 categories 1 and 2, 2.15 types A to F;

- (b) hazard classes 3.1 to 3.6, 3.7 adverse effects on sexual function and fertility or on development, 3.8 effects other than narcotic effects, 3.9 and 3.10;
- (c) hazard class 4.1;
- (d) hazard class 5.1;".

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

These Regulations transpose, in part, Directive 2008/112/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 December 2008 amending Council Directives 76/768/EEC, 88/378/EEC, 1999/13/EC and Directives 2000/53/EC, 2002/96/EC and 2004/42/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council in order to adapt them to Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008 on classification, labelling and packaging of substances and mixtures.

The Regulations amend the definition of hazardous substance in the End-of Life Vehicles Rules 2004, as required by the Directive. The regulations come into operation on 1 December 2010.
