**Title.**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Water Tariff Regulations 2005.

**Potable water tariff.**

2. The price at which potable water is to be supplied shall, during the accounting period including 1 April 2005, and every such period thereafter, be as follows—

- (a) to shipping from Waterport Wharf and North Mole, at the rate of 58 pence per 100 litres;
- (b) to hotels at the rate of 41 pence per 100 litres and in addition thereto a charge to be known as the Standing Additional charge of £5 per calendar month;
- (c) to hospitals and schools at the rate of 58 pence per 100 litres and in addition thereto a charge to be known as the Standing Additional charge of £5 per calendar month;
- (d) by meter or otherwise to domestic consumers at the rate of 21 pence per 100 litres for the first 4,500 litres registered by any one meter in any one month, and at the rate of 52 pence per 100 litres registered in excess of 4,500 litres and in addition

thereto a charge to be known as the Standing Additional charge of £3 per calendar month;

- (e) undelivered supplies from public fountain by small barrels, buckets or similar small containers, at the rate of 14.5 pence per 100 litres;
- (f) to swimming pools, at the rate of £1.16 per 100 litres and in addition thereto a charge to be known as the Standing Additional charge of £5 per calendar month;
- (g) to industrial and commercial users, at the rate of 46 pence per 100 litres and in addition thereto a charge to be known as the Standing Additional charge of £6 per calendar month;
- (h) by meter or otherwise to Government departments and the Ministry of Defence and any other consumers not provided for in paragraphs (i) and (vii) at the rate of 58 pence per 100 litres and in addition thereto a charge to be known as the Standing Additional charge of £5 per calendar month;

#### **Salt water tariff.**

3. The salt water rate shall be—

- (a) in respect of offices, stores, cafes, bars and other like premises at the rate of 2 pence in the pound;
- (b) In respect of tenement buildings, flats and other dwelling houses at the rate of 2 pence in the pound.
