In exercise of the powers conferred by section 214 of the Public Health Act and rule 7A of the Seashore Rules, the Government and the Minister with responsibility for tourism has made the following rules—

Title.

1. These rules may be cited as the Seashore (Amendment) Rules 2014.

Beaches set apart from prohibition on angling.

2. The following beaches or parts of beaches are set apart from the prohibition on angling under rule 7A of the Seashore Rules so that shore fishing is permitted from 15 October to 15 April subject to the conditions in rule 3—

- (a) Eastern Beach;
- (b) Sandy Bay;
- (c) Catalan Bay;
- (d) Keys Promenade, on the north side and south of the wider concourse containing concrete tables including the south facing revetment of that wider concourse;

- (e) The parapet wall adjacent to the car park at Little Bay;
- (f) Little Bay Beach; and
- (g) Camp Bay Pier.

Conditions for angling.

3. The following conditions shall apply to any person angling from the beaches described in rule 2–

- (a) to remove, when leaving the beach, any refuse created by the person;
- (b) to have a first aid kit available (which may be shared with others);
- (c) to exercise due caution, especially in bad weather;
- (d) to permit inspections by authorised officers of the Department of the Environment and Environmental Agency and comply with any instruction by such officer after such inspection together with all lawful instructions of the Royal Gibraltar Police;
- (e) to limit equipment to two rods or lines at any one time, with any spare rod assembled up to the swivel with no trace, hooks or weights;
- (f) to be responsible for any injury or damage, however caused, and not to seek to attach liability for such injury or damage to the Government.
