INTERPRETATION AND GENERAL CLAUSES ACT

PUBLIC UTILITY UNDERTAKINGS ACT

PUBLIC UTILITY UNDERTAKINGS (INTERNATIONAL TELEPHONE ACCESS CODE AND SINGLE EUROPEAN EMERGENCY CALL NUMBER) REGULATIONS 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 23 of the Interpretation and General Clauses Act, and of all other enabling powers, and for the purpose of transposing into the national law of Gibraltar Council Decisions 91/396/EEC and 92/264/EEC, the Government has made the following regulations —

1. Title and commencement.

These regulations may be cited as the Public Utility Undertakings (International Telephone Access Code and Single European Emergency Call Number) Regulations 1995 and shall come into effect on the 22nd day of June 1995.

2. Amendment to Public Utility Undertakings Act.

The Public Utility Undertakings Act is amended by inserting after section 32 the following new section —

“32A. International Telephone Access Code and Single European Emergency Call Number.

- (1) The Government shall provide —
 - (a) as the international telephone access code the number “00”
 - (b) as the emergency call number the number “112”.

- (2) The obligation contained in paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) shall —
- (a) not preclude the continuation of special arrangements for making calls across borders between adjacent member States;
 - (b) extend to integrated services digital networks and public mobile services in addition to the public telephone network.
- (3) The obligation contained in paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) shall be satisfied if the number specified in that paragraph is available in parallel with the existing emergency call number.”.
