AN ACT to amend the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Act.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Act (Amendment) Act 1997.

Amendment to section 2 of the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Act.

2. Section 2 of the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Act shall be amended by inserting after the definition of "employed person" the following definition -

"essential services" means the Royal Gibraltar Police, the Gibraltar Services Police, the City Fire Brigade, the Defence Fire Service, the Gibraltar Health Authority, the Customs Department and the Port Department;"

Amendment to section 3 of the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Act.

3. Section 3 of the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Act shall be amended in subsection (3) by adding after the words "had the employment been in Gibraltar" the words -

"and, in any event, shall be deemed to include employment outside Gibraltar with the essential services".

Amendment to section 10 of the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Act

4. Section 10 of the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Act shall be amended by inserting after subsection (4) the following subsection -

"(5) Nothing contained in subsection (3) shall prejudice the right of an insured person in employment with the essential services to claim benefit in respect of accidents occurring while he is outside Gibraltar in the course of his duties.".
