AN ACT to amend the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance)
Act.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

Title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) (Amendment) Act 2007 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 July 2006.

Amendment of the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Act.

2. The Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Act is amended in section 5 as follows—

(a) the existing provisions of section 5 becomes sub-section (1);

(b) the following is inserted after sub-section (1)—

“(2) No insured person over the age of 60 or one who has retired at age 55 by operation of law shall be liable to make contributions pursuant to the provisions of this Act. For the avoidance of doubt, nothing in this sub-section affects the application of sub-section (1) as it applies to employers.

(3) An insured person whose retirement age is 55 by operation of law and who retires at a prior age shall continue to be liable to make contributions pursuant to the provisions of this Act until age 55 is reached.”.
