LEGAL NOTICE NO. 5 OF 2002

**SOCIAL SECURITY (EMPLOYMENT INJURIES INSURANCE)  
ORDINANCE**

**EMPLOYMENT INJURIES (BENEFITS) (AMENDMENT)  
REGULATIONS 2002**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 50 of the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Ordinance, and all other enabling powers, I have made the following regulations -

**Title and Commencement**

1.(1) These regulations may be cited as the Employment Injuries (Benefits) (Amendment) Regulations 2002.

(2) These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 January 2002.

**Amendment of Regulation 4**

2. Regulation 4 of the Employment Injuries (Benefits) Regulations is amended—

(a) in paragraph (a), by omitting “£23.90” and substituting “£31.80”.

(b) in paragraph (b), by omitting “£47.80” and substituting “£63.60”.

**Amendment of Regulation 8**

3. Regulation 8(b) of the Employment Injuries (Benefits) Regulations is amended by omitting “£31.40” and substituting “£41.80”.

**Amendment of Schedule 2**

4. The Employment Injuries (Benefits) Regulations are amended by revoking Schedule 2, and substituting the following:

**Saving**

5.(1) The amendments effected to the Employment Injuries (Benefits) Regulations by regulations 3 and 4 shall not apply in respect of any accident or successive accidents (as the case may be) occurring before 1 January 2002.

(2) The increased rate of disablement pension under section 16 of the Ordinance shall be payable irrespective of the date of the accident.
