**SOCIAL SECURITY (EMPLOYMENT INJURIES INSURANCE)
ACT.**

**EMPLOYMENT INJURIES (CLAIMS) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 1986.**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 50 of the Social Security (Employment Injuries insurance) Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following regulations:

Title and commencement.

1.(1) These regulations may be cited as the Employment Injuries (Claims) (Amendment) Regulations, 1986.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of January 1987.

Amendment of regulation 14.

2. Regulation 14(2) of the Employment Injuries (Claims) Regulations (hereinafter called the Principal, regulations) is amended by omitting the expression "£10.70" from the proviso, and substituting the expression "£11.40".

Saving.

3. The amendment effected to the principal regulations by regulation 2 of these regulations shall not apply in cases where a gratuity has been awarded in respect of an injury that occurred before the 1st day of January, 1987.
