**SOCIAL SECURITY (EMPLOYMENT INJURIES
INSURANCE) ACT**

**EMPLOYMENT INJURIES (CLAIMS) REGULATIONS
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2001**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 50 of the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Act I have made the following Regulations—

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Employment Injuries (Claims) Regulations (Amendment) Regulations 2001.

Amendment to the Employment Injuries (Claims) Regulations.

2.(1) The Employment Injuries (Claims) Regulations shall be amended as follows—

- (a) in regulation 2 by inserting the following definition in the appropriate place—

“contribution schedule” shall be construed in accordance with the Employment Injuries (Contributions) Regulations 2001;”

- (b) by substituting for regulation 4(1) the following sub-regulation—

“(1) Every employer shall take reasonable steps to investigate the circumstances of every accident suffered by any of his employees which may give rise to a claim to benefit, and where such accident causes loss of life to the insured person, the employer shall send the contribution schedule of the insured person to the Director or such other person as he may require forthwith.”.

(2) References in the Employment Injuries (Claims) Regulations to the “Department of Labour and Social Security”, in all instances where they occur, shall be substituted by references to the “Department of Social Security”.
