**SOCIAL SECURITY (EMPLOYMENT INJURIES INSURANCE)
ORDINANCE**

**EMPLOYMENT INJURIES (QUESTIONS AND APPEALS)
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2006**

In exercise of the powers conferred on her by section 50 of the Social Security (Employment Injuries Insurance) Ordinance, the Minister has made the following Regulations—

Title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Employment Injuries) (Questions and Appeals) (Amendment) Regulations 2006.

Amendment to Schedule.

2. The Schedule to the Social Security (Employment Injuries) (Questions and Appeals) Regulations is amended by substituting the following Part for Part 3—

PART 3

Medical Appeals Tribunal

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| 1. Chairman of the Medical Appeals Tribunal | £50 for each session of the Tribunal not exceeding 4 hours. |
| 2. Each other member of the Medical Appeals Tribunal | £110 for each session of the Tribunal not exceeding 4 hours. |
| 3. Member of the Medical Appeals Tribunals charged with carrying out full medical examination. | £75 for each full medical examination and report. |

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

These Regulations amend the Schedule to the Social Security (Employment Injuries) (Questions and Appeals) Regulations in order to re-set fees for the Medical Appeals Tribunal.
