**SOCIAL INSURANCE ACT.  
(Cap. 145).**

**SOCIAL INSURANCE (AMENDMENT OF CONTRIBUTIONS AND  
BENEFITS) ORDER, 1984.**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 52 of the Social Insurance Act, and of all other enabling powers, and with the prior approval by resolution of the House of Assembly, the Governor has made the following order:

**Title and commencement.**

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Social Insurance (Amendment of Contributions and Benefits) Order, 1984.

(2) Paragraphs 2 and 4 of this order shall come into operation on the 25th day of December, 1984.

(3) Paragraph 3 of this order shall come into operation on the 7th day of January, 1985.

**Amendment of section 20 of Cap.**

2. Section 20(a) of the Social Insurance Act (hereinafter called the Act) is amended by omitting the expression "£19.30", and substituting the expression "£20.30".

**Amendment of First Schedule.**

3. The First Schedule to the Act is amended by omitting everything after the heading, and substituting the following:

**"CONTRIBUTION RATES.**

**"PART I.**

"Section 4.

Class of employed Insured person to whom rate applies	Weekly rate of contribution	
	By the insured person	By the employer
Men who have attained the age of 18 years	£5.90	£6.20
Women who have attained the age of 18 years	£5.90	£16.20
Males who have attained the age of 15 years but are under 18 years	£4.68	£5.01
Females who have attained the age of 15 years but are under 18 years	£4.68	£5.01

"Where the person employed is over pensionable age, only the employer's share of the contribution is payable.

**"PART II.**

Class of self employed insured person to whom rate applies	Weekly rate of contribution by insured person
Men who have attained the age of 18 years	£7.25
Women who have attained the age of 18 years	£7.25
Males who have attained the age of 15 years but are under 18 years	£5.65
Females who have attained the age of 15 years but are under 18 years	£15.65

**Amendment of second Schedule.**

4. The Second Schedule to the Act is amended by omitting Part V, and substituting the following Part:

"PART V.

"RATES OF PERIODICAL BENEFITS AND OF INCREASES FOR  
DEPENDANTS.

"Section 10A.

Description of Benefit	Weekly basic rate	Increase for wife or adult dependant where Payable	Increase for children not exceeding 4,*where payable per child
1. Widow's benefit:			
(a) Widow's allowance	48.20	-	6.00
(b) Widowed mother's allowance	40.60	-	*6.00
(c) Widow's pension	40.60	-	-
1A Widower's pension (incapable of self-support)	40.60	-	6.00
2. Guardian's allowance	10.40	-	-
3. Old age pension:			
(a) where the pension is payable to a woman by virtue of a husband's insurance, and he is alive; or where the pension is payable to a man who is permanently incapable of self-support, by virtue of his wife's insurance, and she is alive	20.30	-	6.00
(b) in any other case	40.60	20.30	6.00

\*Except in the case of a widowed mother's allowance where there is no limit to the number of children in respect of whom increases may be paid."
