#### SOCIAL SECURITY (INSURANCE) ACT

### SOCIAL SECURITY (INSURANCE) (AMENDMENT OF CONTRIBUTIONS AND BENEFITS) ORDER, 1986.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 52 of the Social Security (Insurance) Act, and of all other enabling powers, and with the prior approval by resolution of the House of Assembly, the Governor has made the following order:

#### Title and Commencement.

- 1.(1) This order may be cited as the Social Security (Insurance) (Amendment of Contributions and Benefits) Order, 1986.
- (2) Paragraphs 2 and 4 of this order shall come into operation on the 23rd day of December 1986.
- (3) Paragraph 3 of this order shall come into operation on the 5th day of January 1987.

#### Amendment of Section 20.

2. Section 20(a) of the Social Security (Insurance) Act (hereinafter called the Act) is amended by omitting the expression "£20.90" and substituting the expression "£22.30".

#### Amendment of Schedule 1.

3. Schedule 1 to the Act is amended by omitting everything after the heading, and substituting the following:
