**AN ACT** to amend the Social Security (Insurance) Act to provide for the laying in Parliament of orders made pursuant to section 52; and to provide for the retrospective effect of legislation that revised social insurance contributions rates.

**ENACTED** by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

**Title and commencement.**

1. This Act may be cited as the Social Security (Insurance) (Amendment) Act 2009 and comes into operation on the day of publication.

**Amendment of Act.**

2.(1) In section 52 of the Social Security (Insurance) Act, for subsection (3) substitute the following subsections—

“(3) An order made in pursuance of subsection (2) shall be laid before the Parliament.

(4) If any such order is annulled by the Parliament in pursuance of the provisions of section 28 of the Interpretation and General Clauses Act, then—

(a) any moneys paid in pursuance of such order which, but for that order, would not have been payable shall be repaid or made good; and

(b) subsection (2) of that section shall have effect only in so far as it relates to the duty of a person or authority to revoke the rule.”.

**Retrospective effect of Order.**

3. The Social Security (Insurance) Act (Amendment of Contributions) Order 2009 shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 July 2009.
