SOCIAL SECURITY (NON-CONTRIBUTORY BENEFITS AND UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE) (AMENDMENT OF BENEFITS) ORDER, 1988.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Section 18 of the Social Security (Non-Contributory Benefits and Unemployment Insurance) Act, and of all other enabling powers, and with the prior approval by resolution of the House of Assembly, the Governor has made the following Order:

Title and Commencement.

- 1.(1) This order may be cited as the Social Security (Non-Contributory Benefits and Unemployment Insurance) (Amendment of Benefits) Order, 1988.
- (2) This order shall come into operation on the 27th day of December, 1988.

Amendment of Schedule 3.

2. Schedule 3 to the Social Security (Non-Contributory Benefits and Unemployment Insurance) Act is amended by omitting everything after the heading "Schedule 3", and substituting the following-
