(AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE 3) ORDER 2007**

In exercise of the powers conferred on her by section 18(2) of the Social Security (Non-Contributory Benefits and Unemployment Insurance) Act and with prior approval by resolution of the Gibraltar Parliament, the Minister has made the following Order—

**Title and commencement.**

1. This Order may be cited as the Social Security (Non-Contributory Benefits and Unemployment Insurance) (Amendment of Schedule 3) Order 2007 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 July 2007.

**Amendment of Schedule 3.**

2. For Schedule 3, Parts I and I(A) there shall be substituted the following Schedule—
