SOCIAL SECURITY (INSURANCE) ORDINANCE

**SOCIAL INSURANCE (CONTRIBUTIONS) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 2005.**

In exercise of the powers conferred on her by sections 6, 8, 9 and 43 of the Social Security (Insurance) Ordinance, the Minister has made the following regulations—

Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Contributions) (Amendment) Regulations 2005 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 July 2004.

Amendment to the Social Insurance (Contributions) Regulations.

2. The Social Insurance (Contributions) Regulations are amended by substituting for regulation 15(1) the following regulation—

“Maternity.

15.(1) A contribution as an employed person shall be credited to an insured woman for any week in which she is absent from work in exercise of her right to maternity leave under the Employment (Maternity and Health and Safety) Regulations 1996.

(2) Contributions under sub-regulation (1) shall be credited to an insured woman for a maximum period of 18 weeks.”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

These regulations provide that social insurance contributions are credited to a woman on maternity leave for up to 18 weeks.
