LEGAL NOTICE NO. 141 OF 1985.

**SOCIAL INSURANCE ACT.  
(Cap. 145).**

**SOCIAL INSURANCE (INSURABILITY AND SPECIAL CLASSES)  
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1985.**

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 3, of the Social Insurance Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following regulations:

**Title and commencement.**

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Insurability and Special Classes) (Amendment) Regulations, 1985.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the 6th day of January, 1986.

**Amendment of Schedule of Booklet 6 of Cap. 145.**

2. The Schedule to the Social Insurance (Insurability and Special Classes) Regulations, is amended by omitting everything after the heading "Schedule", and substituting the following:

**"EMPLOYMENT'S OR SELF- EMPLOYMENTS TO BE  
DISREGARDED.**

Employment or self-employment (not being employment or self-employment specified in the-next succeeding paragraph) of a person by any one employer or in a self-employed capacity on any day or days in any contribution week on which that person renders service in that employment or self-employment where such services are rendered for less than fifteen hours in that week.</p>	<p>2. Employment or self-employment of a person cleaning or other Domestic work by any one employer or in a self-employed capacity on any day or days in any contribution week on which that person renders services in that employment or self-employment where such services are rendered for less than fifteen hours in that week.</p>	
<p>4. Employment as a fountain attendant by or under the Government of Gibraltar</p>	<p>4.Any person in employment specified in paragraph 4 of the first column where remuneration in respect of such employment is 75p or more a week.</p>
