SOCIAL INSURANCE (INSURABILITY AND SPECIAL CLASSES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1985.

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 3, of the Social Insurance Act, and of all other enabling powers, the Governor has made the following regulations:

Title and commencement.

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Insurability and Special Classes) (Amendment) Regulations, 1985.

(2) These regulations shall come into operation on the 6th day of January, 1986.

Amendment of Schedule of Booklet 6 of Cap. 145.

2. The Schedule to the Social Insurance (Insurability and Special Classes) Regulations, is amended by omitting everything after the heading "Schedule", and substituting the following:

4. Employment as a fountain attendant by or under the Government of Gibraltar	4.Any person in employment specified in paragraph 4 of the first column where remuneration in respect of such employment is75p or more a week.
