## SOCIAL SECURITY (INSURANCE) ACT.

### SOCIAL SECURITY (INSURANCE) APPORTIONMENT OF CONTRIBUTIONS NOTICE, 1988.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 24(1D) of the Social Security (Insurance) Act, I hereby issue the following notice:

#### **Title.**

1. This notice may be cited as the Social Security (Insurance) Apportionment of Contributions Notice, 1988.

#### **Apportionment.**

2. The contributions payable under the Social Security (Insurance) Act shall be payable to the Pension Fund and to the Shortterm Benefits Fund in the proportions specified in the Schedule hereto.

#### SCHEDULE PART I

The proportion of contributions payable under the Act in respect of employed persons.
