**SOCIAL SECURITY (INSURANCE)
(APPORTIONMENT OF CONTRIBUTIONS) NOTICE, 1991.**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 29(1D) of the Social Security (Insurance) Act, I hereby issue the following notice:—

Title and commencement.

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Social Security (Insurance) (Apportionment of Contributions) Notice, 1991.

(2) This notice shall come into operation on the 6th day of January, 1992.

Apportionment.

2. The contributions payable under the Social Security (Insurance) Act shall be payable to the Pensions fund and to the Short-term Benefits Fund in the proportions specified in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

PART I.

The proportion of contributions payable under the Act in respect of employed persons.

Contributor	Amount payable to Pensions Fund	Amount payable to Short-term Benefits Fund
Males and females who have attained the aged of 18 years but are under pensionable age	£10.00	£2.88
Males and females who have attained the age of 15 years but are under the age of 18 years	£7.18	£2.55
Married women and widows who have elected not to pay social Insurance, women over the age of 60 years and men over the age of 65 years.	£5.00	£1.44

The proportion of contributions payable under the Act by self-employed persons.

Contributor	Amount payable to Pensions Fund	Amount payable to Short-term Benefits Fund
Males and females who have attained the aged of 18 years	£6.86	£1.44
Males and females who have attained the age of 15 years but are under the age of 18 years	£4.93	£1.27

PART III

The proportion of contributions payable under the Act by voluntary contributors.

Contributor	Amount payable to Pensions Fund	Amount payable to Short-term Benefits Fund
Males and females who have attained the aged of 18 years	£5.18	£1.44
Males and females who have attained the age of 15 years but are under the age of 18 years	£3.79	£1.27
