# SOCIAL SECURITY (CLOSED LONG-TERM BENEFITS AND SCHEME) ACT 1996

# SOCIAL SECURITY (CLOSED LONG-TERM BENEFITS AND SCHEME) (AMENDMENT OF BENEFITS) REGULATIONS 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 38 of the Social Security (Closed Long-Term Benefits and Scheme) Act 1996, and all other enabling powers, the Minister has made the following Regulations—

### Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Closed Long-Term Benefits and Scheme) (Amendment of Benefits) Regulations 2023 and shall come into operation on 1 August 2023.

### Amendment of the Social Security (Closed Long-Term Benefits and Scheme) Act 1996.

- 2.(1) The Social Security (Closed Long-Term Benefits and Scheme) Act 1996 is amended in accordance with the provisions of this regulation.
- (2) In Section 16(a) for "£260.25" substitute "£278.50".
- (3) In Schedule 1 for Part 1 substitute –
