**SOCIAL SECURITY (CLOSED LONG-TERM BENEFITS)  
(QUESTIONS AND APPEALS) REGULATIONS (AMENDMENT)  
REGULATIONS 1999**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 27 of the Social Security (Closed Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act 1997 I have made the following regulations –

**Title.**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Closed Long-Term Benefits) Regulations (Amendment) Regulations 1999.

**Amendment to the Social Security (Closed Long-Term Benefits) (Questions and Appeals) Regulations.**

2. The Social Security (Closed Long-Term Benefits) (Questions and Appeals) Regulations shall be amended -

(i) by substituting for regulation 11 the following regulation –

“ 11. The fees payable out of the fund to the Chairman and members of the Board in respect of each sitting of the Board and to medical practitioner appointed under regulation 4 shall be as set out in the Schedule.”;

- (ii) for the schedule, there shall be substituted the following schedule –

**“SCHEDULE**

Regulation 11.

**SCALE OF FEES**

To the chairman of the Board	£50.00
To any member of the Board who has to the satisfaction of the chairman actually lost wages as a result of attendance.	The amount of such lost not exceeding £30
To each medical practitioner on reference to him for examination and/or medical opinion on a question or claim.	£50.00”.
