**AN ACT** to amend the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act 1997.

**ENACTED** by the Legislature of Gibraltar.

**Title and commencement.**

*Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act, 1997 (Amendment)*  
*Act, 1999* [No. 23 of 1999]

1. This Act may be cited as the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act 1997 (Amendment) Act 1999 and shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 5th July 1999.

**Amendments to the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act 1997.**

2. The Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act 1997 shall be amended in section 4 by inserting after subsection (7) the following subsection -

“ (8) Notwithstanding subsection (1), no contribution shall be payable in respect of an employee for any week during the whole or any part of which she is absent from work in exercise of her right to maternity leave under the Employment (Maternity and Health and Safety) Regulations 1996.”.
