SOCIAL SECURITY (OPEN LONG-TERM BENEFITS SCHEME) ACT, 1997

SOCIAL SECURITY (OPEN LONG-TERM BENEFITS SCHEME) (AMENDMENT OF BENEFITS) ORDER, 2012

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 46 of the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act, 1997, and all other enabling powers, and with the prior approval by resolution of the Gibraltar Parliament, the Minister has made the following Order—

Title and commencement.

1. This order may be cited as the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) (Amendment of Benefits) Order, 2012 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 August 2012.

Amendment of Section 22(a).

2. Section 22(a) of the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act, 1997 ("the Act") is amended by omitting "£199.42" and substituting "£207.80".

Amendment of Schedule 2.

3. Schedule 2 to the Act is amended by omitting Part 1, and substituting the following Part—
