#### SOCIAL SECURITY (OPEN LONG-TERM BENEFITS SCHEME) ACT 1997

## SOCIAL SECURITY (OPEN LONG-TERM BENEFITS SCHEME) (AMENDMENT OF BENEFITS) (No.2) ORDER 2016

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 46 of the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act 1997, and all other enabling powers, and with the prior approval by resolution of the Gibraltar Parliament, the Minister has made the following Order—

#### Title and commencement.

1. This Order may be cited as the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) (Amendment of Benefits) (No.2) Order 2016 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 August 2016.

### Amendment of the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act 1997.

- 2.(1) The Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act 1997 is amended in accordance with the provisions of this paragraph.
- (2) Section 22(a) is amended by substituting "£220.31" for " 219.44".
- (3) Schedule 2 is amended by substituting the following Part for Part 1–
