## SOCIAL SECURITY (OPEN LONG-TERM BENEFITS SCHEME) (AMENDMENT OF BENEFITS) ORDER 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 46 of the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act 1997, and all other enabling powers, and with the prior approval by resolution of the Gibraltar Parliament, the Minister has made the following Order –

#### Title.

1. This Order may be cited as the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) (Amendment of Benefits) Order 2021.

#### Commencement.

2. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st August 2021.

### Amendment of the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act 1997.

- 3.(1) The Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act 1997 is amended in accordance with the provisions of this paragraph.
  - (2) In section 22(a), for "£236.85", substitute "£241.85".
  - (3) Schedule 2 is amended by substituting the following Part for Part I–
