SOCIAL SECURITY (OPEN LONG-TERM BENEFITS SCHEME) (AMENDMENT OF BENEFITS) ORDER 2023

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 46 of the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act 1997, and all other enabling powers, and with the prior approval by resolution of the Gibraltar Parliament, the Chief Minister has made the following Order—

Title and commencement.

1. This Order may be cited as the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) (Amendment of Benefits) Order 2023 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 August 2023.

Amendment of the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act 1997.

- 2.(1) The Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act 1997 is amended in accordance with the provisions of this paragraph.
- (2) In Section 22(a) for "£260.25" substitute "£278.50".
- (3) In Schedule 2 for Part 1 substitute—
