**SOCIAL SECURITY (OPEN LONG-TERM BENEFITS SCHEME)  
ORDINANCE, 1997**

**SOCIAL INSURANCE (OPEN LONG-TERM BENEFITS)  
(CONTRIBUTIONS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2004**

In exercise of the powers conferred on her by Section 8 of the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Ordinance, and of all other enabling powers, the Minister has made the following regulations—

**Title and commencement**

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Open Long-Term Benefits) (Contributions) (Amendment) Regulations, 2004.

(2) These Regulations come into operation on 3 January, 2005.

**Replacement of Regulation 20**

2. The Social Insurance (Open Long-Term Benefits) (Contributions) Regulations are amended by revoking regulation 20 and substituting the following new regulation—

**“Rates of arrears**

20. The weekly rate at which arrears are payable shall be as follows—

(a) by employed persons—

- (i) in respect of any period from 5 January, 1998 up to and including 2 January, 2005; £12,00; and
- (ii) in respect of any period from and after 3 January, 2005; £13.00.

- (b) by self-employed persons–
  - (i) in respect of any period from 5 January, 1998 up to and including 2 January, 2005; £7.86; and
  - (ii) in respect of any period from and after 3 January, 2005; £8.52.”.
