**SOCIAL SECURITY (OPEN LONG-TERM BENEFITS)
(CONTRIBUTIONS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2007**

In exercise of the powers conferred on her by sections 4(5), 6, 7, 8 and 39 of the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act 1997, the Minister has made the following Regulations—

Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits) (Contributions) (Amendment) Regulations 2007 and are deemed to have come into operation on 1 July 2006.

Amendment to the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits) Regulations.

2. The Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits) Regulations are amended in regulation 12(1) as follows—

(a) for the heading there is substituted the following—

“Credits for persons aged 60 or over or having attained statutory retirement age.”

(b) in paragraph (a) for “and” substitute “or”;

(c) paragraph “(b)” becomes paragraph “(c)”; and

(d) the following paragraph is inserted after paragraph (a)—

“(b) has retired at age 55 by operation of law;”.
