SOCIAL SECURITY (OPEN LONG-TERM BENEFITS SCHEME) ACT 1997

SOCIAL SECURITY (OPEN LONG-TERM BENEFITS) (CONTRIBUTIONS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2007

In exercise of the powers conferred on her by sections 4(5), 6, 7, 8 and 39 of the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act 1997, the Minister has made the following Regulations—

Title and commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits) (Contributions) (Amendment) Regulations 2007 and are deemed to have come into operation on 1 July 2006.

Amendment to the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits) Regulations.

- 2. The Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits) Regulations are amended in regulation 12(1) as follows-
 - (a) for the heading there is substituted the following-

"Credits for persons aged 60 or over or having attained statutory retirement age."

- (b) in paragraph (a) for "and" substitute "or";
- (c) paragraph "(b)" becomes paragraph "(c)"; and
- (d) the following paragraph is inserted after paragraph (a)—
 - "(b) has retired at age 55 by operation of law;".
