(QUESTIONS AND CLAIMS) REGULATIONS (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 1999**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 31B of the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits Scheme) Act 1997 I have made the following regulations:—

Title.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits) (Questions and Claims) Regulations (Amendment) Regulations 1999.

**Amendment to the Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits)
(Questions and Claims) Regulations.**

2. The Social Security (Open Long-Term Benefits) (Questions and Claims) Regulations shall be amended -

(i) by substituting for regulation 8 the following regulation -

“ 8. The fees payable out of the fund to medical practitioners appointed under regulation 4 shall be as set out in the Schedule.”;

- (ii) for the schedule, there shall be substituted the following schedule -

“SCHEDULE

Regulation 8.

SCALE OF FEES

To each medical practitioner
on reference to him for examination
and/or medical opinion on a question
or claim.
